



#### How optimistic are you about the health of your business now, compared to before the Coronavirus pandemic?






91% expressed that the Coronavirus pandemic will negatively impact their business over the next 3 months.


77% expressed it will negatively impact their business over the next year.

#### How has the Coronavirus pandemic already affected your current workforce?






### How do you expect the Coronavirus pandemic to impact your workforce in the next 3 months?






### Have you had to reduce hours of staff as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic?






# 12% of businesses had to temporarily shut down or close due to the Coronavirus pandemic!

#### What percentage of your staff has been laid-off or had a reduction in hours as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic?






#### How will the Coronavirus pandemic impact your business from a hiring standpoint?

Our research team was able to categorize open-ended answers into six categories.





### What services or resources does your business/organization need to help deal with the Coronavirus pandemic?

Our research team analyzed the open-ended answers.

Answers varied widely.

However, nearly 50% of the open-ended responses identified needing some type of funding whether through loans, grants, increased cash flow, deferment of payments, etc.



41% of businesses said they are providing new benefits to customers as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic.

#### What where the majority of new benefits being offered to customers as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic?

Our research team analyzed the open-ended answers.

50% of the open-ended responses related to late fee waivers, delaying payment terms, reducing penalties, providing refunds, offering discounted services, ensuring no service disruption, etc.

34% of responses related to new service lines, consulting, and providing access to free virtual resources and consultions.


